Dog Tags and Licences: Every dog in the Township requires a tag. The tag is for the lifetime of the dog, but the licence must be renewed yearly. Licences expire December 31st of each year.

- \$15 per dog on or before April 30th
- \$20 per dog after April 30th
- \$5 per dog replacement tags

2024 Interim Taxes

2024 Interim Taxes are **due** on **February 28th** and **April 30th**. Penalty for late payment is at the rate of 1.25% per month, effective the 1st day of the month of default and each month thereafter.

Tax Payment Options Available:

- a) Pre-authorized Payment plan There are no service fees and you can choose to pay on the due date or with a monthly plan. Details and the PAP Application Form are on the Paying Property Taxes webpage.
- b) Visa/MasterCard Payment Link available on the township website or over the telephone. Taxpayer is responsible for the 2.25% service fee.
- c) Telebanking or internet banking Pay at least 2-3 days prior to due date to allow for transmission and processing.
- d) In-person at most banks (contact your bank for details) -You must have your tax bill with you when making payments.
- e) Send cheques via Canada Post Taxpayer assumes responsibility for late arrival. Do not send cash.
- f) Leave cheques in the drop box located at the main doors of the municipal building in Warsaw for after-hours payments. Do not leave cash.

Snow Removal and Winter Parking

It is a violation under the Highway Traffic Act, Section 181 to plow, shovel, blow or place snow on or across public roadways. Putting snow on roadways creates unsafe conditions for motorists. The act of placing snow on the roadways often happens after the snow plows have finished the plow routes and staff have reported the roads clear. People who place snow on a roadway may expose themselves to liability if the hazard caused by placing snow results in an accident.

Parking on Township roads is prohibited, especially during the winter months to allow for winter maintenance operations. Motorists who breach winter parking regulations may be towed and will be responsible for all costs incurred.

Waste Disposal

Have curbside garbage and recycling out by 7:00 a.m. and leave it out until 7:00 p.m. on your collection day.

Curbside collection schedule from January – July 2024:

- Family Day, February 19th: recycling collection cancelled, but garbage to be collected as usual
- Easter Monday, Victoria Day, Canada Day recycling and garbage collection as usual
- Good Friday, March 29th: recycling collected as usual, but garbage collection moved to Saturday, March 30th

Residential: 2 bags max. per week - 1 with tag, 1 without tag Business: 4 bags max. per week - 2 with tags, 2 without tags Garbage tags are available at the Municipal Office – 3 free for permanent residents and 20 free for seasonal residents. Additional tags are \$3.00 each.

All garbage must be bagged in clear bags: max weight 40lbs/bag, max volume of 2ft³, remove all food waste, recycling and household hazardous waste.

- Permits are issued yearly and expire December 31
- For multi-site agricultural burn permits, or general help getting a permit contact the Fire Administrator!

Smoke alarms expire! Don't see a date on the outside of the alarm? Then it's likely older than 10 years and needs to be replaced. You must maintain the same type of smoke alarm in your home that was required when it was built. If the alarms are hardwired and interconnected, any replacements need to be the same. If your alarm has a strobe light, the replacement alarm needs a strobe light too. If your strobe lights are separate, then these don't expire as long as they continue to work. With so many alarm options available, contact us if you need help selecting the right alarm!

Did you get a gift over the holidays that is powered with a lithium ion rechargeable battery? Thermal runaway events can lead to fires and explosions. Be informed – never overcharge your batteries, stay with them while they're charging and only use the cables and chargers from the original manufacturer.
